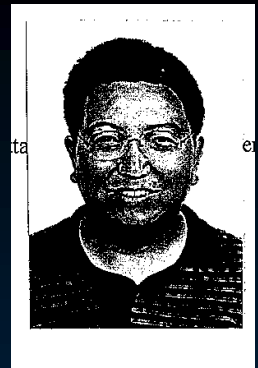

- **The Capital Institute of Pediatrics (CIP)**
  - first research institution of its kind in China,
  - specializes in child health care and basic research, prevention and treatment of childhood disorders
  - medical services for children
  - higher education for college students.
- There are 1,100-odd staff members in the CIP, mostly professionals
- The institute includes the WHO Collaborating Center for Child Health.
- In the last 20 years, over 200 students graduated to have a PhD or MSc

# Breastfeeding in Australia: Institutional context and Policy

- **Community based mother to mother support**
  - Australian Breastfeeding Association established in 1964
- **Federal system, with responsibilities divided between Commonwealth and State governments**
  - Health care agreements on funding
- **Recent Commonwealth Parliamentary Inquiry 'BestStart'**
  - National Breastfeeding Strategy
- **WHO International Code on Marketing of Breastmilk Substitutes**
  - Marketing Agreement on Infant Formula (MAIF) Voluntary Agreement by Formula Industry
  - NHRMC Dietary Guidelines including Infant Feeding Guidelines and Recommendations
  - Consumer protection through FSANZ and ACCC and related State government agencies
- **BFHI implementation in Australia via ACM**
